

Data Protection and Privacy for all Individuals within the European Union (EU) and the European Economic Area (EEA).

Privacy Statement

1 Information concerning the collection of personal data

(1) The following information describes how we collect personal data from visitors who use our website. Personal data is all data that is personally attributable to you, such as name, address, email address, usage behaviour.

(2) The controller according to Art. 4 (7) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is

(3) When you contact us by email or by using a contact form, we will store the data you provide (your email address, where relevant your name and your telephone number), in order to respond to your inquiry. We will delete all collected data once no longer required for storage unless we are legally obligated to store such information.

(4) If we use contract service providers, or if we wish to use your data for advertising purposes, we will inform you of the details and the relevant storage period. You shall have the right to refuse such data usage per the description found below.

2 Your rights

(1) You have the following rights with regard to your personal data:

- the right to access (confirmation),
- the right to rectification or erasure,
- the right to restrict the processing,
- the right to object to the processing,
- the right to data portability.

(2) You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority regarding how we process your personal data.

3 Collection of personal data when visiting the website

(1) If visitors use our website solely for informational purposes, we will only collect the personal data that your browser relays to our server. If you wish to view our website, we will collect the following data, which we need for technical reasons in order to display our website to you, and to ensure its functionality and security:

- IP address
- date and time of the inquiry
- time zone difference to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
- content of the inquiry (specific page)
- access status/HTTP status code
- respective volume of data relayed
- website from which the request originates
- browser
- operating system and its interface
- language and version of the browser software.

The legal basis for this data processing is Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR.

(2) Alongside the aforementioned data, cookies will also be stored on your computer when using our website. Cookies are small text files stored on your hard disk by your browser to make site-specific information available to the website using the cookie (in this case, our website). Cookies cannot run applications or transmit viruses to your computer. Their purpose is to make the general online experience more user-friendly and effective.

(3) Use of cookies:

This website only uses transient cookies. Transient cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser. This also particularly includes session cookies. These store what is known as a session ID, which correlates various queries made by your browser during one single session. This helps to identify your computer when you return to the website. Session cookies are deleted once you log out or close your browser.

You can configure your browser settings accordingly to block third-party cookies or all cookies in general. Please note that in this case you may not be able to use all the services provided by this website.

4 Objection or withdrawal of consent to the processing of your data

(1) If you have given your consent for your data to be processed, you can withdraw this at any time. This withdrawal of consent will affect the permissibility of the processing of your personal data, starting from the time you inform us of the withdrawal.

(2) In the event that we use a balancing of interests to justify the processing of your personal data, you are entitled to object to this processing. If you choose to exercise your right to object, we ask you to please provide us with the reasons why your personal data should not be processed. If your objection is justified, we will either cease or modify the data processing, and if not justified we will explain the reasons behind our refusal.
